#### **GCSE Maths & GCSE English**



#### **RESIT NOVEMBER 2020**

Anyone who has not yet achieved a Grade 4 in GCSE Maths/English has the opportunity to achieve this either by resitting the qualification or by entering for functional skills qualification (if they got a grade 2or below) later in the year. Those who have been selected for the GCSE will be taking the exam in November 2020.

## 1. Exam Dates

## 2. Procedures

Students should attend Sixth Form as normal on the morning of each exam arriving on time and in the correct tutor room at 8:30am. Form Tutors will then direct students to the exam room that they will be sitting their resit in.

#### 3. Exam Access Arrangements

At school you might have been granted Exam Access Arrangements. This would mean that when you sat your GCSE exams in school you had an amendment such as; additional time, coloured paper, a separate room or a reader.

# These Exam Access Arrangements do not automatically carry over.

Ormiston Bolingbroke Academy's exam team have already reassessed the Exam Access Arrangements for students resitting examinations this term.

## 4. Payment

As a Sixth Form we do not require payment for examination entry. However, if you **fail to attend for any of your examinations you will be charged a £20 exam entry fine** to cover the costs of entering you for the examination. This will be sent out as an invoice requesting payment.
