Throughout this half term students in year 9 have been learning about 'Street Safety' which is particularly important for young people as they start to become more independent and they spend more time with their peer groups. As part of this unit, students have covered a range of different topics including bonfire night safety, gang and knife crime and racism.

We were also very lucky to have not one but two external visits which enriched this newly developed project. We welcomed Collaborate Digital to school who delivered an excellent presentation on the prominent issue of Violence Against Women and Girls a fortnight ago. Last week we welcomed two Firefighters from Cheshire Fire and Rescue Service who talked to students about road safety as a pedestrian, as a passenger in a car, as a driver of a car and also as a cyclist. Today your child has learned about the racially motivated murder of Anthony Walker.

Students have engaged really well with this project and I hope they are now more aware of the risks and dangers which exist in independent situations. I am confident that you will be pleased to know that we are teaching this sort of material to your children and that we are working with external agencies as to enrich your child's Lessons for Life programme. I encourage all parents/carers to discuss this interaction at home with your child.
