## **RE: Industrial strike action**

I am writing to you with an update around the next strike days of Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April and Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2023 and what this means for our academy.

Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May is already on the calendar as an Inset day, so there is no impact for students.

However, as a result of the strike we will not have enough members of staff to safely open the academy to all students on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April. We will therefore be open to students as follows;

• Years 12 and 13 will have access to use the study room.

We are requesting you inform us if your sixth form child will be attending school on 27<sup>th</sup> April. Please email <u>s.richardson@ob-ac.co.uk</u> or <u>attendance@ob-ac.co.uk</u> to confirm if your child will be attending school or not. You must also confirm that you give permission for your child to leave site during the day.

- Those students on the vulnerable register (if this applies to your child you will receive a phone call). Students on the vulnerable register can wear non uniform on this day.
- Year 11 students will be offered a combination of revision sessions and the use of a study room. The normal timetable will not be followed. Any year 11 absence on this day will be treated as unauthorised as the school is open to this year group.

Year 11 students can choose to wear non uniform for this day only. If they intend to participate in sporting activities, they should wear appropriate dress.

All other students must remain at home during the days specified above, and we ask that they use the time to study using Seneca, Tassomai and BBC Bitesize. The Oaks Academy have a number of lessons that can also be accessed.

School will close at 12.30pm on 27<sup>th</sup> April, students will be able to purchase a lunch should they wish to do so before leaving school.

If your child is entitled to receive a free school meal, please email <u>admin@ob-ac.co.uk</u> to request, by Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> April, and your child can collect a packed lunch on the day.
