**Dear Parents and Carers** 

As the last day in school for students is Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> July 2023, before the Summer holidays begin, we have decided to allow students to attend school in their own clothes on this day.

Please consider appropriate clothing for this day as it is still a normal school day.

School will close for all students at 12:30pm on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> July 2023.

I would also like to take this opportunity to make you aware of some key information in preparation for the new academic year.

## **Pastoral Structure**

Due to several internal promotions and maternity covers our pastoral team has had a re-structure. The team for September 2023 is attached at the end of this letter.

If your child's form group is one of the ones that has been affected, you will receive an additional letter in the coming weeks to confirm who their new tutor is. Please be reassured that changes have been made thoughtfully by pastoral staff and a wide range of factors have been considered before placing students in a particular new group.

### **Uniform and Equipment**

I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you, well in advance, of our uniform and equipment requirements for September. We are very proud of our school uniform at OBA and believe its smart appearance reflects the high standards we set for our students in terms of learning, attitude, and behaviour. As part of this, we have strict expectations that ensure consistency for all.

Most students wear our uniform correctly and with pride and sincere thanks go to those students. There are a small minority of students who do not always uphold our high standards and therefore I thought it would be useful to include a detailed summary below. Please note that these expectations are not new, but we are reinforcing them for everyone's clarity.

From September, skirts and pinafores must be of an appropriate length. As a guide this should be at, or just above, the knee. I accept that, more recently, this may not have been brought to your attention or proactively applied consistently across the school. This must change to ensure the standard of dress is observed by all. It is parents' responsibility to ensure that the correct length is purchased. It is the student's responsibility to ensure they are worn correctly and not rolled/hitched up.

As always, school trousers are a viable alternative.

I must stress that any student who returns with a skirt/pinafore of an inappropriate length will not be allowed to attend lessons and the behaviour policy will be invoked immediately.

## Hair, Make-up, Jewellery and Accessories

The expectations regarding this are very clear but please be reminded that:

- No false/acrylic/gel nails or varnish is allowed
- Brows must be natural
- Hair should be a natural colour extreme colours/styles and accessories are not permitted
- False eye lashes are not permitted
- The only jewellery that is permitted is one pair of silver or gold small studs.

## Shoes – Please see attached guide.

- Shoes should be plain, black school shoes.
- Trainers, pumps and heels are not permitted.















#### **Coats**

Outdoor coats must be removed on entry to the academy.

#### **Equipment**

Here is the basic list of essentials:

- School bag handbags are not permitted
- Pencil case
- 2 black or blue ball point pens
- 2 HB pencils
- Eraser
- Pencil sharpener
- 30cm ruler
- Purple biro

Once again, thank you for your support in upholding our standards. It is an important part of our overall behaviour strategy, and it supports our students in being ready for the world of work where uniform is expected across a range of sectors. Sometimes, parents and students question our attention to detail and ask how uniform impacts on learning. The answer to that is simple:

The uniform creates a unique sense of OBA identity. The uniform ensures everyone is equal. Wearing a uniform makes everyone feel that they are 'at work' and it impacts positively on attitudes to learning.
