



- 1) 1 side should be a name / formula / quote / question.
 - 2) 1 side should the facts / knowledge / answers.
 - 3) No more than 3 max on the information side.

Ideas you can whip up in a Flash(card)

- English: Character + Quote / Chapter + Summary / Character + Adjectives
- History: Figures + Facts / Event Name + Description
- Science: Keyword + Definition / Formula + How it works
- Maths: Practice question + Answer / Formula + How it works
- Psychology: Research Method + How it works / Case Study + Evidence
