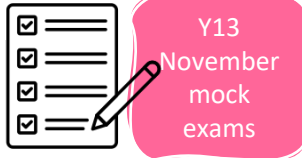
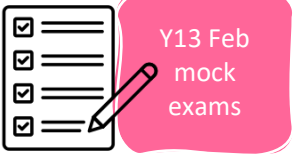

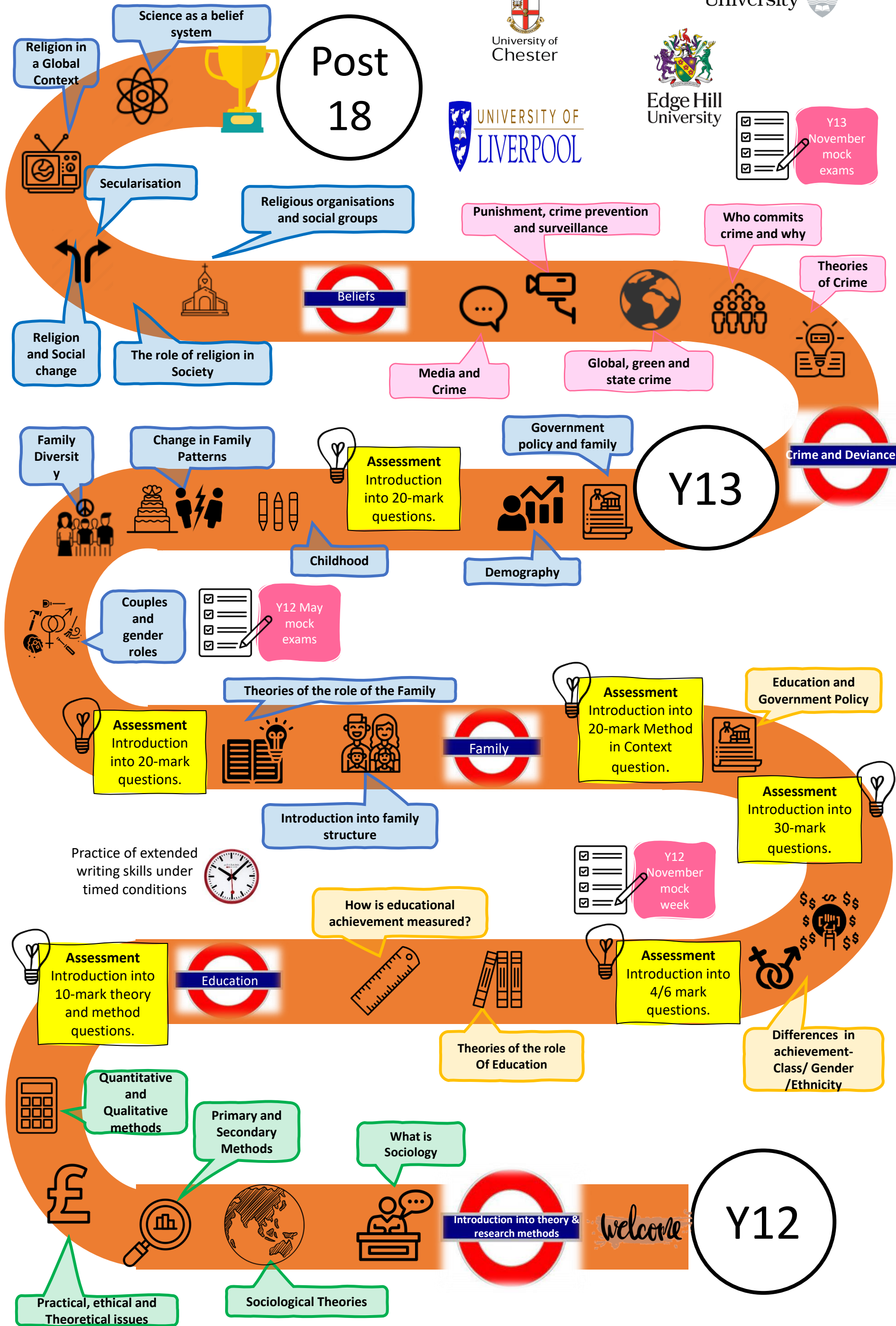
Want to change your society?
